Company Program Grades 9-12 En/Fr

Investment Strategies Grades 9-12 En only

In this virtual opportunity, students receive a virtual portfolio of \$100,000 and learn about the stock market as well as other financial health and literacy topics and then have an opportunity to manage trades within a national competition.
