Supports Curriculum: math, social studies, language arts

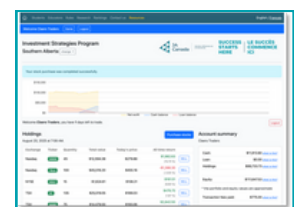
